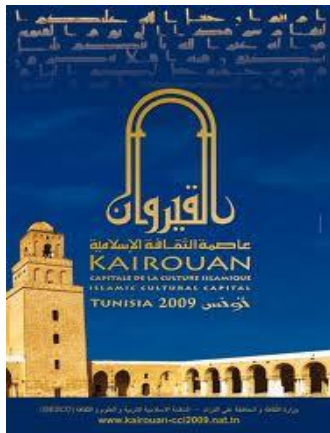

Kairouan city: Tunisia's Islamic heritage

Kairouan is referred to as the Islamic Cultural Capital. The city was founded by the Arabs around 670. In the period of Caliph Mu'awiya, it became an important centre for Islamic and Quranic learning, and thus attracting a large number of Muslims from all over of the world, next only to Mecca and Medina. The holy Mosque of Uqba is situated in the city. It is considered as Islam's fourth holiest city.



Amphitheatre El JEM

The Amphitheatre of El Jem is one of the rare monuments of its kind and unique in Africa, which is not built against a hillside, but on flat ground and supported by a complex system of arches. The monument of El Jem is one of the most accomplished examples of Roman architecture of an amphitheatre, almost equal to that of the Coliseum of Rome.
